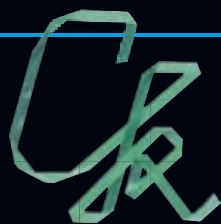

## 10-MeterForest

The new Emil&Samuel Restaurant on Steen&Strøm Department Store's 5. floor has it's own glowing forest. Oslo based lighting designer Cathrine Kullberg has designed a ceiling and wall installation of pure wood and light, stretching almost 100 square meters above the restaurant area, ending in a 10 meter long curved and laser cut birch veneer frieze. The veneer is paper thin, and when back lit, it glows through the wood.

The birch veneer has been laser cut with a forest motif. The pine trees sway, while squirrels and foxes, owls and eagles hide between the trees. Above the restaurant guests, the forest continues, with cut out pine cones, moons, bats and eagles flying, all back lit.
