



# Norwegian Forest table light



Norwegian forest lights draw on a classic Scandinavian tradition of using thin birch strips for lighting. Norwegian Forest lights show a deep pine forest with animals in light and shade. An eagle registers movement on the ground – is it prey or predator? When lit, the blonde birch veneer shines with a warm glow, and the delicately cut forest motif allows snow white light to filter out between the highlights of the trees.

The shade is made from thin birch veneer mounted on white paper. The veneer is carefully laser cut by a skilled airplane model maker. The steel frame is custom made at a metal workshop and powder coated white. Thin natural leather lace is twined around the legs, to soften the touch against the table surface. The shell is then hand sewn onto the frame using leather lace. All the parts are assembled by hand in the designer's Oslo studio.

#### Norwegian Forest comes in three versions:

Table light	(Ø 32, H 59 cm)
Small pendant light	(Ø 32, H 34 cm)
Large pendant light	(Ø 55, H 45 cm)

#### Production

In small workshops in different parts of Norway. Assembled in designer's Oslo studio.

#### Dimensions

Ø 32, H 59 cm

#### Materials

Shade: 0,6 mm untreated birch veneer mounted on white paper.  
Lacer cut forest motif.  
Steel lamp stand (5mm rods), white powder coated.  
1,5 mm natural leather lace.  
Cord: length 3 m, white (other lengths available on request).  
Lamp holder with switch.

#### Weight

2,5 kg

#### Maintenance

Careful dusting, avoid liquids on the veneer

#### Light source

Incandescent, E27-size, max 60W.
